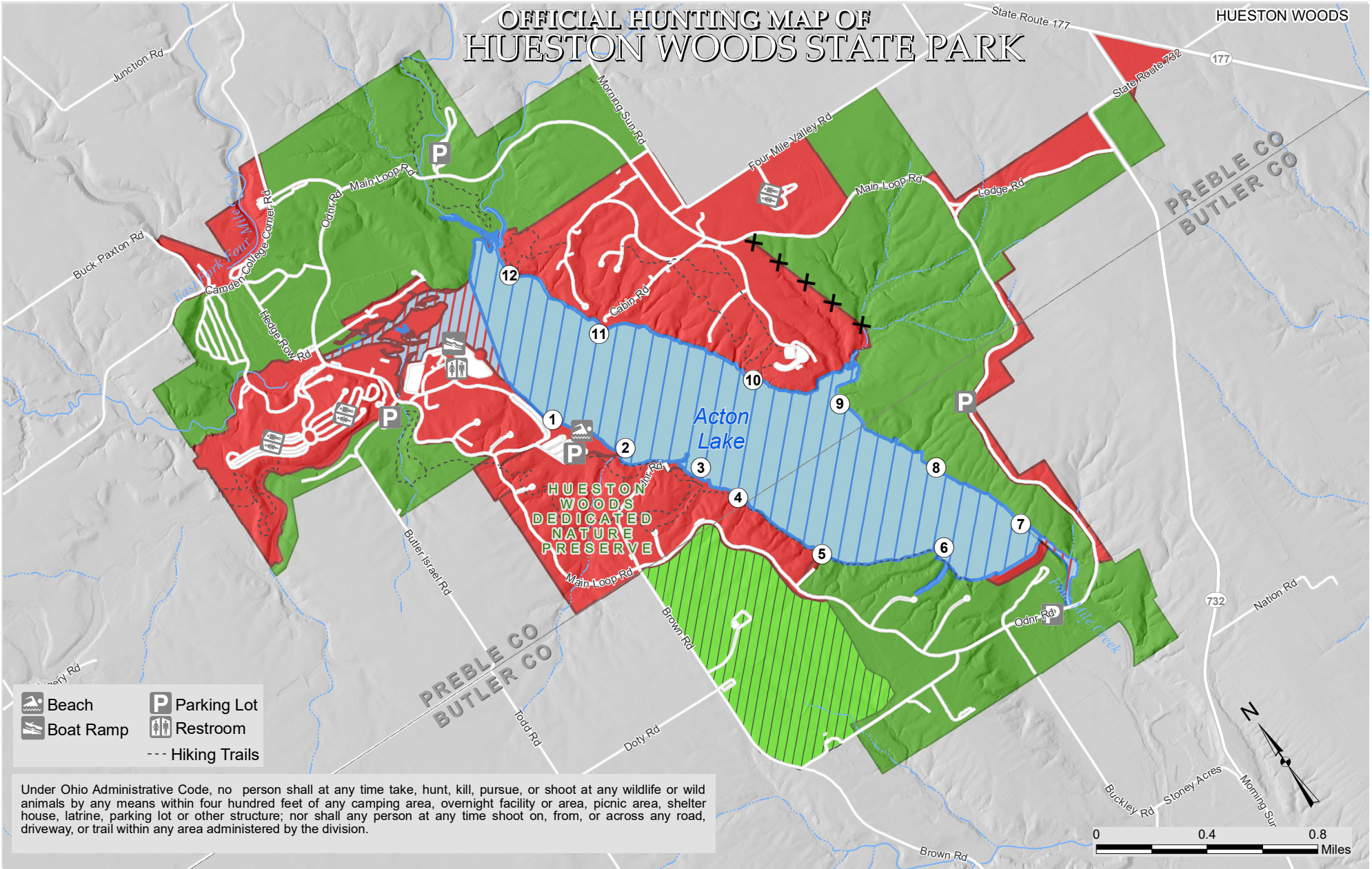


OFFICIAL HUNTING MAP OF HUESTON WOODS STATE PARK

Under Ohio Administrative Code, no person shall at any time take, hunt, kill, pursue, or shoot at any wildlife or wild animals by any means within four hundred feet of any camping area, overnight facility or area, picnic area, shelter house, latrine, parking lot or other structure; nor shall any person at any time shoot on, from, or across any road, driveway, or trail within any area administered by the division.

- Waterfowl and Trapping by Permit Only, Raccoon Hunting (10pm - 5am), Trapping by Permit Only in accordance to Ohio Hunting and trapping regulations.[†]
- Open to Hunting, Trapping During Season[†]
- Hunting Permitted by permit only or by boat[†]
- Closed to Waterfowl Hunting
- Closed to Hunting

[†]Other than permitted hunting, Hueston Woods hunting season is October 15 through February 28 in accordance with Ohio Hunting and Trapping Regulations. Hunting prohibited after 10:00 am during the early migratory season.
